Overview

Mitten Bites are one of the products that the students created. They have become a substantial source of funding for the after school program, in fact all revenues of Mitten Bites are redirected to fuel the mission of Detroit Food Academy: helping the youth of Detroit.



The Product

Mitten Bites are pocket sized granola bars made by the students. These all-natural snack bars are packed with nutrition and flavor. There are no additives or preservatives, just 7 carefully curated wholesome ingredients to make one perfectly satisfying snack. All flavors are soy-free, wheat-free, dairy free, and cholesterol-free. Each case comes with 16 delicious bars.





Ingredients and Allergens

Dark Chocolate + Peanut Butter: Oats, Peanut Butter, Michigan Honey, Shredded Coconut, Organic Fair Trade Dark Chocolate(soy free), Organic Vanilla Extract, Organic Cinnamon

Apple + Cinnamon: Oats, Slow Jams Apple Jam (Michigan Apples, Michigan Sugar, Fruit Pectin, Lemon Juice, Cinnamon), Sunflower Seeds, Cranberries, Dates, Organic Vanilla Extract, Organic Cinnamon

** Soy-free, wheat-free, dairy-free, cholesterol-free, sodium-free

Blueberry + Lavender: Oats, Slow Jams Blueberry Jam (Michigan Blueberries, Michigan Sugar, Fruit Pectin, Lemon Juice), Sunflower Seeds, Cranberries, Dates, Organic Vanilla Extract, Organic Cinnamon

Rhubarb + Ginger: Oats, Slow Jams Rhubarb Jam (Rhubarb, Ginger, Michigan Sugar, Fruit Pectin, Lemon Juice, Cinnamon, Vanilla), Sunflower Seeds, Cranberries, Dates, Organic Vanilla Extract, Organic Cinnamon

Product Specifications

Each Mitten Bite bar contains two servings each measuring 2" x 2"

The packaging per bar measures 5" x 2.5" (length x breadth)

The product can be divided into two based on the ingredients used and this results in a slight difference in shelf life

Samples can be made available for each flavor



Honey Based - Dark Chocolate Peanut Butter	120 Days
Jam Infused - Blueberry + Lavender - Apple + Clnnamon - Rhubarb + Ginger	90 Days

Refrigeration increases the life of the product as well however, so far, the products have been sold without needing any.

Pricing and Distribution

The pricing is based on the number of cases ordered. The product can be ordered based on demand. Each case contains 16 Bars of Mitten Bites. The pricing will include shipment charges since the product is made in Detroit, MI. The chart will work out to be as under:

Number of Cases	Price per Case	Shipment	Wholesale Price per bar (Including shipment)
0 - 9	\$21	\$10	\$1.40
10 -19	\$20	\$20	\$1.32
20 - 49	\$19	\$30	\$1.25
50+	\$18	\$30	\$1.15

The retail price is suggested at anywhere between \$2.00 - \$2.25 since the vast majority of targeted consumers will be students
